Job Description

Job Title: Part Time Worship Leader

Job Responsibilities

- Lead and direct congregational and choir music for regular church services:
 - Sunday – 11:00 am
 - Sunday – 6:00 pm (as needed)
 - Wednesday – 7:00 pm (as needed)
- Lead and direct congregation and choir music for special services including, but not limited to: Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Revival
- Lead and direct weekly choir rehearsal and special rehearsals as needed (e. g. Christmas Cantata)
- Select and prepare all music (blend of traditional and contemporary) for rehearsals, weekly services and special services (for choir and congregation)
- Communicate weekly with Pastor about music needs and to correlate music with sermons
- By the end of Wednesday evening service, have the following Sunday AM service music selected and ready for the Musician
- Communicate weekly with Musician about music needs and inform them of any special instrumental needs
- Provide Administrative Assistant with a list of all congregational hymns for the PowerPoint and any necessary choir announcements for the bulletin, by Tuesday at close of office (to be published for following Sunday AM service)
- Maintain up-to-date phone tree information for choir members
- In the event of absence, with the exception of unavoidable emergencies, the Choir Director must make suitable arrangements for their coverage
- Possess a vibrant, growing personal relationship with Christ and share their passion for worship with those they lead in ministry
- Possess a cooperative spirit, strong interpersonal skills, and engage their audience

Job Requirements

- Must be able to select, prepare, and direct congregational and choir music

Germanton Baptist Church is seeking a part time Worship Leader. The position will require a commitment of approximately 3-4 hours per week. Under the guidance and direction of the Pastor, the worship leader will be responsible for selecting and leading music for weekly worship service (Sunday at 11:00am), choir specials (during Sunday AM service), choir practice (Wednesday 8:00pm) and special services. Our church desires to move to a blended worship experience, incorporating traditional and contemporary music, for both congregation and choir. The Worship Leader will work closely with pianist to select music to complement the Pastor's message.

It is important this person possess a vibrant, growing personal relationship with Christ and shares their passion for worship with those they lead in ministry. They must also possess a cooperative spirit, strong interpersonal skills, and engage their audience.
