Part-Time Position Responsibilities

- Serve as an integral part of the staff team working to further the church's over-all vision including a continued building of youth and children's programs.
- Participate in weekly staff meetings with pastor(s) and worship planning team.
- Supervise the repertoire of youth and children's materials and oversee the organization thereof.

- Provide oversight to program volunteers; ensure training and administration of budget line item(s)
- Coordination of Youth and Children's Ministry including education and ordering literature.
- Scheduling of appropriate retreats and/or outings.
- Teaching or supervision of teachers for specific classes or programs.
- Other responsibilities as requested by Senior Pastor.
